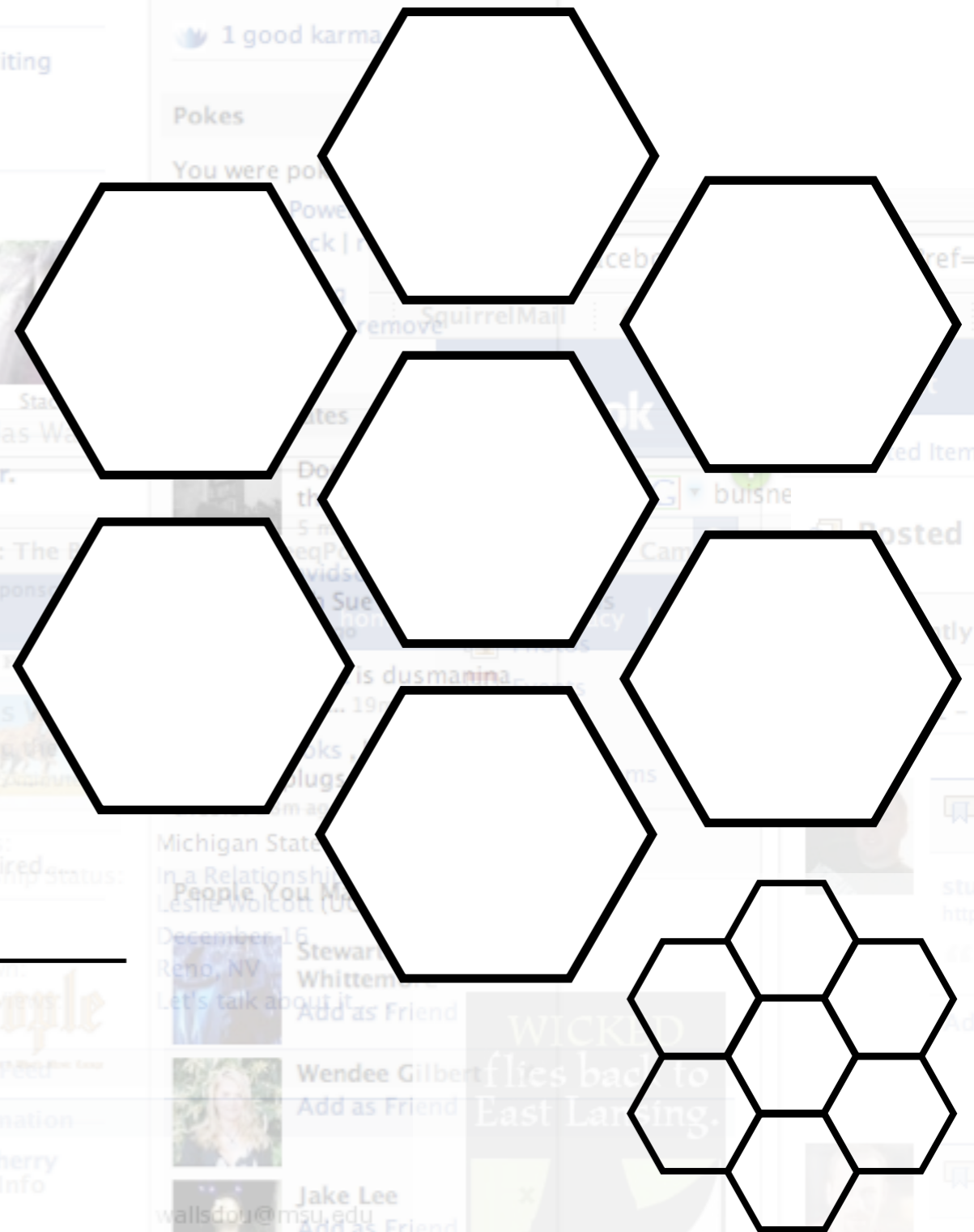


# ENC 1102H Honors Composition II: Writing, Rhetoric, and Research in New Forms
